<u>Librarian's Report</u>

The Trustees accepted the Librarian's Report.

In addition, Ms. Cara Russell noted the following:

There was a predictable seasonal decline in the activity statistics. Of note, the library has 8,000 active patrons.

The process to elect Trustees has been strengthened. Joyce Cowan consulted with us on our procedures and noted that we should post a notice of cancellation of the election if no one new is being nominated for a position. We will enter into an agreement with Ms. Cowan to be the coordinator for the next election cycle. John Sone suggested putting a copy of the election process document in the library's Policy and Procedure Manual. Cara Russell suggested that it would be an appropriate document for the Director's process Manual and have a brief statement in the library's manual that the Board of Trustees is responsible for the election procedures.

The new e- Audio and e-Book programs are set to be launched on 10/14/13.

Cara Russell stated that she has been evaluating whether or not employees should be able to roll over 2 weeks of unused vacation rather than the 1 week currently allowed. This will be an Action Item for the next meeting.

Other items for the October agenda: David Price from Trinity Resources meeting with the Board; beginning the budgeting process; move Hayes Informed to December meeting.

The August financial statements reflected unusually high payroll tax expense because it included both employee and facility taxes in the one category. There was also a question about sales tax revenue as it was depicted in Quick Books. That designation has been corrected. With these matters resolved, the financial reports for both July and August were accepted.
