## Haunted House Contest Guidelines

**Build your house on a base** no larger than 18"x18". It can of course be smaller. Your base can be anything that is sturdy enough to safely hold your entry for transport and public display.

**Create** your haunted house from recycled boxes, containers, reused and found items, etc.

**No purchased kits, please! Plan, gather, and create your haunted house.**

**\$5.00 Limit on Expenditures-Just to keep it Fair.**

Additional materials for decoration and detail can of course be recycled or reused things, but may also be created from paper or craft supplies.

No keepsakes or sharp objects should be included. Entries will be on open display.

**Enter-**Bring both your house and the completed form to the library and ask for Marie, Sharon or other available person. All entries must be checked in by staff and tagged for display and blind judging.

Entries will be accepted from Oct. 1 till Oct. 18. All houses will be displayed at the library. So, show off your great creation and enter early in October!

### Judging

All entries will be judged on Skill of Execution in relation to the entry category, Overall Appearance, Uniqueness and Creative Use of Recycled Materials.

One prize in each category will be awarded.

Winners will be notified by, and prizes may go home on October 31<sup>st</sup>.
