## Scarecrow Competition Rules



1. **Complete the Entry Form!**
2. **Check-in your scarecrow entry at the library beginning Oct. 12 till Oct. 26.** Staff will point you to your location for set up.
3. Winners announced by Oct. 28. Enter early so your scarecrow will be seen for up to three weeks and also help decorate the library during October.
4. One prize per category will be awarded. Winners will be asked to visit the library ASAP so that prizes can be awarded & photos taken!
5. Individuals, families, or club groups may enter.  
Entries from individuals must be the creative work of the named individual. Assistance in setting up is allowed. Family groups should include adult(s) and young people. Clubs such as Scouts, Garden Clubs, Book Groups, etc. may also enter.
6. Title of Entry & category should be part of the scarecrow display. Index cards are available at the library for your convenience.
7. Content on all entries should be suitable for viewing by all ages.
8. Scarecrows, 4-6 ft. tall, must be able to stand with proper support or sit on a box in some way. The porch is stone so no staking will be possible. You must provide the means to display your scarecrow! No materials are provided.
9. Smaller, table-top, scarecrows will be displayed in the Children’s Room. You should provide a suitable display board for your scarecrow tableau.
10. The library cannot be responsible for the security of any entries. *Do not include family keepsakes!* The library reserves the right to remove any scarecrows if they become unsightly or damaged.
11. **Scarecrows may be displayed as early as Oct. 12 and may remain on display through Nov. 7.** You may pick up your scarecrow Nov. 1-7 during library hours. Any remaining past Nov. 9 may be discarded.
