87 participants
Members who spoke with participants after the meetings said that they heard nothing but positive comments regarding the format. Several also told them that they had not been aware of the planning for a new library for Dripping Springs.
- B. Discuss and consider options for establishing a building committee which would work with PGAL and Library personnel and Board members to plan a design for the new library building.

Based on the input received at the Feb. 2 meetings, PGAL will put together a report showing their vision of what a new library should look like.

The Board will begin researching possible members for the Building Design Committee and will discuss this again later this month.

This new Committee will serve at the pleasure of the Board. This committee will work between the Board and the architects regarding programming, layout, space planning and design. Possible members would be library personnel, educators, adult library users, Home School parents, parents of small children, community members who are experienced in construction, and Friends of the Dripping Springs Library.
