Ages 2 - 8

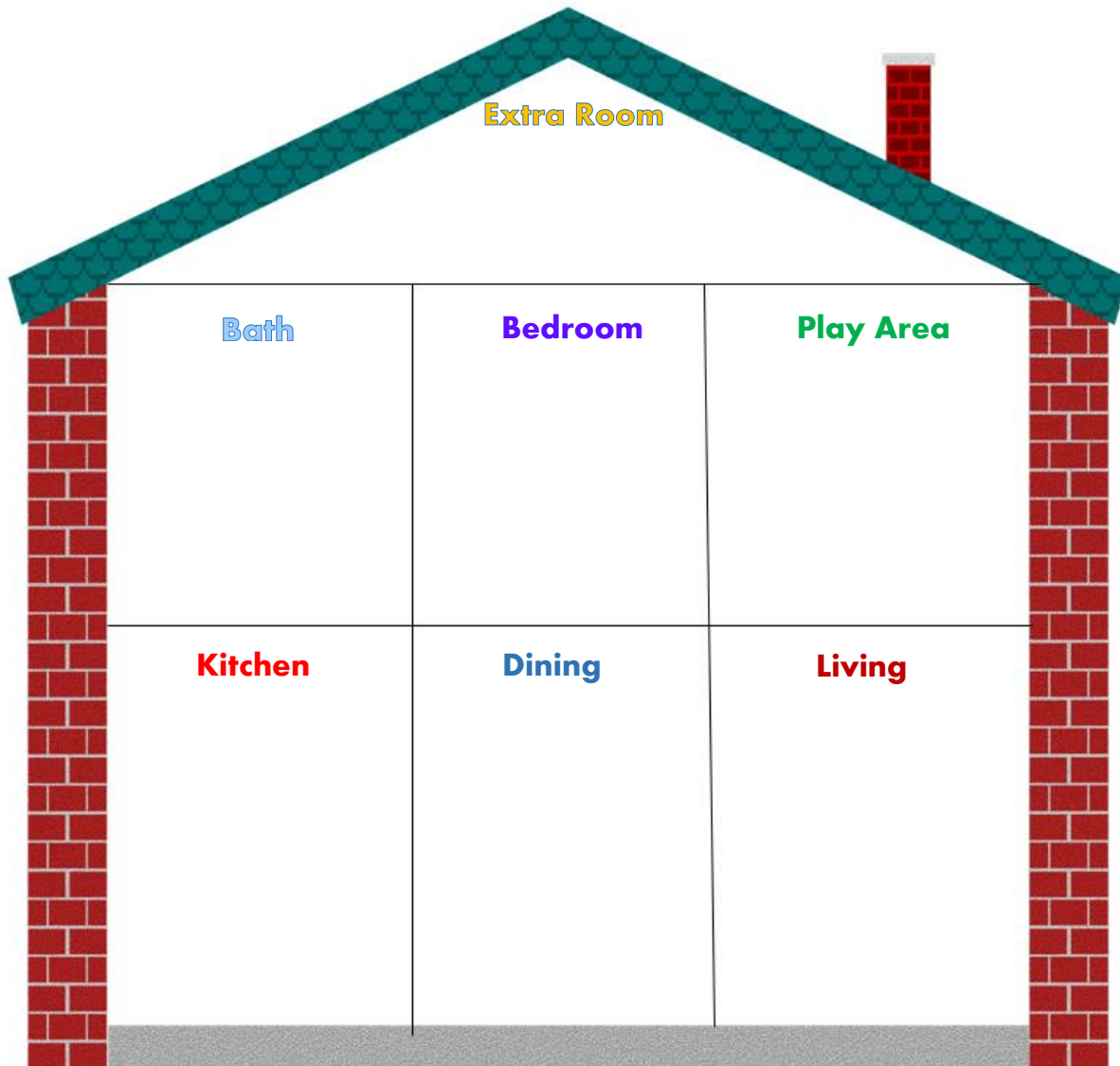
Read in at least 4 rooms in the house. Read a book, magazine, recipe, cereal box, instructions, can or box label, any, and everything you can read or listen to it being read.

Ms. Mouse – a Reading Scavenger Hunt

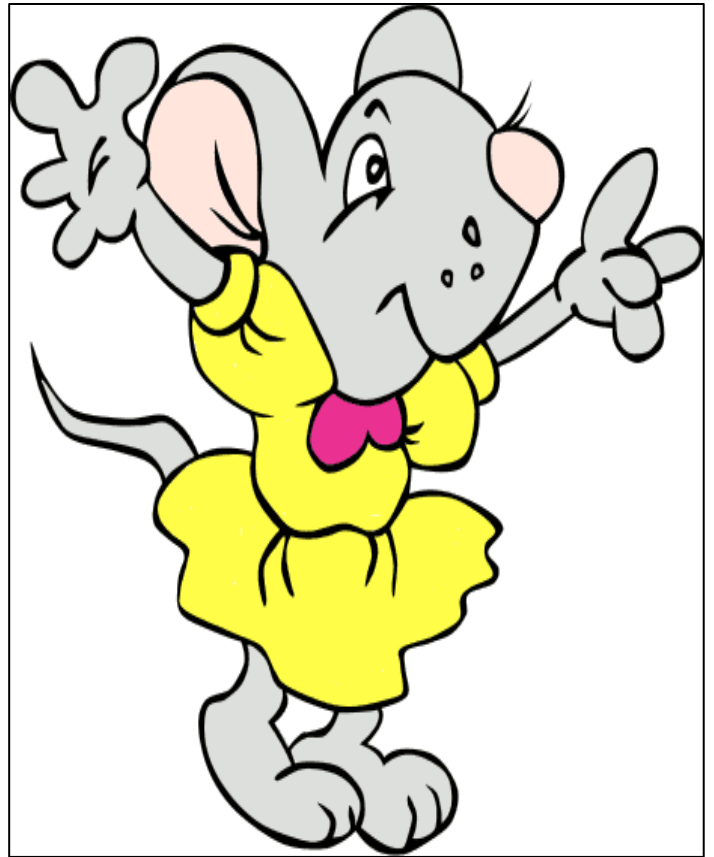
Ms. Mouse is ready to read with you around the house!
